ANNOUNCEMENT FOR NON-DOMESTIC PRODUCER PRICE INDEX

The Producer Price Index (PPI) measures the average change over time in the selling prices received by domestic producers for their output.

Domestic Producer Price Index (D-PPI) calculated by the Turkish Statistical Institute, measures the average change over time in prices of domestic sales of certain products.

PPI for industry is calculated separately for domestic and non-domestic market according to EU Short-Term Business Statistics regulations. For the purpose of providing a more comprehensive producer price index for decision makers and researchers, producing statistics competent at international standards, comparable and compliant to EU norms, Non-Domestic Producer Price Index (ND-PPI) has been calculated to measure producer price changes of products exported from domestic production. ND-PPI will also be published in monthly basis to measure the average change over time in the export prices received by domestic producers for their output.

ND-PPI will be released with the base year of 2010, according to the NACE Rev.2 classification and including industry sector as chain index allowing more up-to-date products coverage and weights. The classification code and definitions of the sections of NACE Rev.2 covered by ND-PPI are given below:

Code	Definition
B	Mining and quarrying
C	Manufacturing

ND-PPI series will be published according to NACE Rev.2 sections (B- Mining and quarrying, C- Manufacturing,) and divisions at the lowest level (2 digit sub-sections, 10-Food products, 11- Beverages, etc.) from January 2010 figuring the monthly index numbers on the TurkStat website.

ND-PPI news bulletin will firstly be published on February 27, 2014. By March 2014, ND-PPI is to be published on every 20th of the month, and if the date corresponds with a public holiday, it is to be released on the next working day.
